Here off to the Colepooya Archers for the fine shoot that they sponsored for the Oregon Bow Hunters Field Tourney held at Cottage Grove. This club is one of the clubs within our state that has affiliated with the Rod and Gun club of their area and I wish every archer in our state could have as fine of a club house, range and facilities that they have. The surrounding clubs pitched in and gave some help to the organization of this shoot, the members of the host club worked long and hard to make our tourney a success. This shoot was the largest shoot we've had to date, some 350 bow hunters competed. I think they ordered too hot of weather but the rest of the conditions were close to perfect. They had a unique novelty shoot, with merchandize prizes for the winners, small permanent trophies were awarded to the one day and out of state shooters. A drawing, based on both score and luck was held. During classifying of the winners, the prizes being merchandize, donated by local merchants and archery distributors from several different states. The Southern Oregon Archery League, donated beautiful handmade trophies that were presented to the instinctive champions of each division to be kept as a permanent trophy. Also, the host club donated a beautiful trophy to the highest scoring Junior boy, on the Big Game Round. This was won by Gary Washburn, from Salem. Bill De Salles, Portland, turned in a tremendous overall score of 1398, shooting 493 on the field round, this set a new state record, replacing the old record of 1267, also set by Bill. Bill scored with 4 arrows on all but 3 targets and shot "30" on 14 targets. We're very proud to have Bill in our organization, but I might add that his score makes me feel useless.

Thank a million, to the many bowhunters that volunteered to help with registration and scoring of the hundreds of cards and scores that were turned in, without your help the shoot would still be in progress.
